Clarification on AGMT Continuing Education Recertification Requirement

To All Certified Glaziers:

We'd like to provide some clarification surrounding the AGMT Continuing Education Recertification Requirement (for full details on AGMT Recertification Requirements, see the AGMT Candidate Handbook, Section 8.2). What Qualifies as Continuing Education?

The AGMT Program will accept any training that falls into the AGMT Body of Knowledge (Candidate Handbook, Section 4.2, page 15, Body of Knowledge):

Examples of the types of evidence that will be accepted:

- OSHA 30 Card
- Manufacturer-specific training (i.e. participation in Kawneer Mechanic's School)
- Training course provided by a membership organization (i.e. Local District Council, Industry Association-provided course)
- Online training course (i.e. <https://www.myglassclass.com/>)

Please note, the above list are examples of acceptable Continuing Education, though it's not the only type of training that is accepted, nor does the AGMT Program endorse any specific Continuing Education provider or course.

Submittal of Continuing Education

To submit evidence of completion of Continuing Education, please email us at staff@agmtprogram.com

Information will be reviewed, and you will be notified of acceptance (or denial) of the information, including whether or not additional evidence is needed, if applicable.”

When’s the latest I can submit evidence of Continuing Education?

At a minimum, 16 hours of Continuing Education (CE) evidence must be submitted and accepted by the AGMT Program every Two years after your date of initial certification (32 hours every Four years). For example, if you were certified on August 1, 2019 you are required to demonstrate that you have received 16 hours of CE prior to August 1, 2021 and another 16 hours prior to August 1, 2023.

Due to the time needed to review evidence, we recommend that you do not wait until your 2-year certification date to submit evidence as we cannot guarantee that we can review the evidence in the same day it’s submitted. Rather, a good way to ensure your evidence is accepted by your due-date is to submit the evidence after you have met the minimum AGMT requirement (i.e. 16 hours of Continuing Education every 2 years).
